### The Specs:

- **Width:** Maximum 2 ¾ inches
- **Length:** Maximum 7 inches
- **Clearance:** Minimum 3/8 inch
- **Height:** Maximum 3 inches
- **Weight:** Maximum 5.000 ounces. No loose materials are allowed on or inside the car. The car may be hollowed out and built up to the maximum weight by additional materials that are firmly secured to the car.

### In addition, the cars will be inspected for the following:

- **Wheels and Axles:** *Official Cub Scout Grand Prix Pinewood Derby* wheels and axles must be used as provided in the kits you received. Flash present in the wheel's axle hole or on the outside may be removed. Similarly, burrs on axle shafts and heads may be removed by polishing. **Wheels may not be modified, and cannot be wafered, beveled, ridged, crowned, drilled, or similarly functionally altered.**
- **Lubrication:** No Lubrication is authorized this year.
- **Detailing:** Detailing such as steering wheels, driver, decals, and paints are permissible as long as they are secured and do not exceed the maximum length, width and weight specifications.
- **Prohibited Items:** The car must be free-wheeling; no starting or launch devices; and shall not ride on any type of springs or suspension system. Wheel bearings, washers, bushings, and **one-piece axles shall not be used.**

Cubs' pictures will be taken as each racer arrives for weigh-in and registration.

***All cars will remain impounded until all racing, including the Finals, is complete. Cubs may then pick up their cars, or make their own arrangements to have someone else pick up their car.***

Following the Awards Ceremony, the cars will be available for pickup along with the ribbons for each car.

Den Leaders will receive Participant Patches to distribute to their Den.
